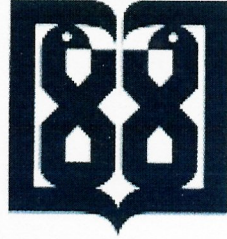

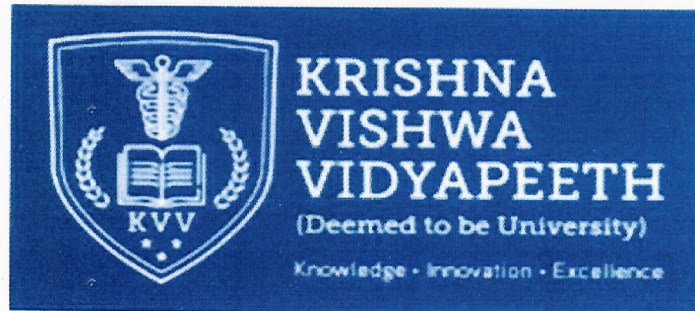

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made by and between Tehran University of Medical Sciences hereafter referred to as "TUMS" and Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Karad, Maharashtra, India hereafter referred to as "KVV(DU)", Karad.

Tehran University of Medical Sciences (TUMS) is the oldest and most well-known medical center in Iran, nationally as well as internationally. TUMS, as one of the country's top research universities, accepts applications from the most qualified students. It also has the largest schools of medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, rehabilitation, allied medical sciences, public health, advanced technologies in medicine, nutritional sciences and dietetics, and nursing and midwifery in Iran as well as a virtual school. Over a hundred specialized research centers such as Science and Technology in Medicine, Rheumatology, Auditory, Digestive Disease, Skin Diseases and Leprosy, Trauma, Hematology and Oncology, Cardiovascular Diseases, Endocrinology and Metabolism, Reproductive Health, Urology, Immunology, and Asthma and Allergy are under the immediate supervision of this university.

TUMS has many teaching hospitals: Imam Khomeini, Sina, Shariati, Vali-e Asr, Amir Alam, Ziaian, and Baharloo are general and referral hospitals; Children's Medical Center and Bahrami Hospital are TUMS pediatric centers; Farabi Hospital is a special center for ophthalmology; Razi Hospital is devoted to dermatology; Roozbeh Hospital is a center for psychiatry; Arash and Moheb-e Yas are special hospitals for gynecology, obstetrics and infertility; Tehran Heart Center is a cardiology center; and Cancer Institute, as the name suggests, specializes in cutting-edge cancer research and treatment.

In addition, TUMS has excellent sports facilities for academics and students. These factors, along with the abilities and drive of its specialists, have made TUMS an important center with a notable reputation in the region and Central Asia.



TUMS having its registered office at No. 21, Dameshgh St., Tehran 14167-53955, Iran is represented by Dr. Mohammad. H. Nekoofar working as Director of International Relations of the first part;

TUMS is accredited by Ministry of Health and Medical Education and is a certified University.

Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Karad (KVV(DU)), (formerly known as Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences "Deemed to be University", Karad (KIMSDU)) a University declared under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956 by Ministry of Human Resources Development, Govt. of India, vide notification No. F.9-15/2001-U.3 dated May 24, 2005 having its registered office at Near Dhebewadi Road, Malkapur - 415539, Tal. Karad, Dist. Satara represented by Dr. M. V. Ghorpade, aged 57 years working as Registrar (which expression shall unless the meaning or context otherwise requires shall mean and include its successors and assigns) of the second part;

Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Karad (KVV(DU)) is accredited by NAAC with 'A+' grade and is an ISO 9001:2015 certified University.

Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Karad (KVV(DU)) has the constituent faculties namely Medical, Dental, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Allied Sciences and Pharmacy offering undergraduate and postgraduate courses. It also runs PhD programmes and Post-Doctoral Fellowships in various subjects.

Each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties".

WHEREAS the Parties consider the common interest in promoting mutual cooperation in the area of education and research and shared interests in pursuing academic and scientific goals and professional and cordial relations;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and representations set forth, the Parties have set forth the following MoU as follows:



Article 1 – Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational cooperation on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote sustainable partnerships and mutual understanding between both Universities.

Article 2 – Scope of Activities

Both Universities undertake to promote and develop academic cooperation through, but not restricted to, academic exchanges of students and faculty, scientific research, dual degree programs, scholar visits, short-term study tours, cultural exchange, exchange of academic materials, publications, other scientific information, professional internships and technical cooperation.

Article 3 – Financial Arrangement

Both Universities agreed that all specific arrangements and plans for activities are to be negotiated and agreed in writing. All agreements shall be made dependent on the availability of funds.

The parties hereby acknowledge that there may be costs and expenses arising under the terms and conditions of this Memorandum of Understanding and each party hereto agree to bear its own costs and expenses unless mutually agreed otherwise by both parties.

Article 4 – Activity Agreements

A detailed description of the scope of activities shall be defined in separate Activity Agreements for implementation (such as Student Exchange Agreements, Joint Research Agreements, Faculty Exchange Agreements, etc.).

The Activity Agreements will include such terms as:

- 4.1 Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed upon activity
- 4.2 Schedules for the specific activity
- 4.3 Budgets and sources of financing for each activity
- 4.4 Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.



Article 5 – Intellectual Property Rights and Publication

Detailed management of Intellectual Property Rights and Publication shall be defined in specific agreements.

Article 6 – Settlement of Differences

Differing viewpoints and interpretations of the MoU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article 7 – Duration & Termination

This MoU shall become effective on the date of final signing and will be for a period of three years or the date upon which the Parties sign the Activity Agreement, whichever occurs later, renewable on written mutual consent. Either University, may, in its absolute discretion, terminate the MoU by giving at least six months 'written notice. Notwithstanding any such termination, all commitments already made in respect of particular Exchange Students or academics shall be carried out till completion.

Article 8 - Surviving Provisions

Clauses 5, 6, and 9 will survive indefinitely the termination or expiration of this MoU.

Article 9 - Notices

Any notice, demand, offer, request or other communication required or permitted to be given by either Party pursuant to the terms of this MoU must be in writing.

Article 10 - Counterparts

This MoU is written in English only.

It is executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same MoU.




Article 11 - Assignability

This MoU may not be assigned or otherwise transferred by either party to a third party without the prior written consent of the other party.

This Memorandum of Understanding completed in English is hereby signed in two (2) original copies with one (1) copy remaining in the possession of each institution. All texts being equally valid. The MOU should be Visible on websites of both the institutes.
