

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN

KUWAIT UNIVERSITY Khaldiya, Kuwait City, Kuwait



AND

TEHRAN UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES Tehran, Iran

The Tehran University of Medical Sciences and Kuwait University agree to implement this Memorandum of Understanding.

This agreement is based on the principle of reciprocity and expresses the interest of both parties in exchanging scholars, students, academic information and materials in the belief that the research and educational process at both institutions will be enhanced and that mutual understanding between their respective scholars and students will be increased by the establishment of such collaborative programs.

- The universities agree to encourage the development of the following collaborative programs based on their respective academic and educational needs:
 - Exchange of faculty
 - Academic program development
 - Exchange of students (undergraduate and/or graduate)
 - . Joint supervision of M.Sc. and Ph.D. students
 - Exchange of academic information and materials
 - Organization of joint research programs
 - Organization of joint conferences
 - Organization of other academic exchanges agreeable to both universities
- The parties recognize that the implementation of any exchange program will depend upon the
 academic interests and expertise of individual faculty members and upon the availability of
 financial resources. Accordingly, the implementation of each exchange program based on
 this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both universities.

- 3. This agreement is not intended to be a legally binding document. It is meant to describe the nature and to suggest the guidelines of the cooperation described above. Nothing therefore shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.
- 4. The agreement shall become effective on the day representatives of both universities affix their signatures and seals, will be in force for a period of five years, and is subject to revision or modification by mutual written agreement. It shall be extended automatically for an additional period of five years at each expiration date unless either party gives a six-month advance notice in writing to terminate the agreement. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the agreement at any time, although is assumed that such action would only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to the other institution.
- A liaison officer from Tehran University of Medical Sciences will be appointed. For Kuwait University Prof. Firyal Bou Rabee, Vice President for Academic Affairs shall serve as liaison officer for this agreement.

Agreement on Scholarly Exchange and Collaboration between Kuwait University and

Tehran University of Medical Sciences

- Kuwait University, (located in Khaldiya, Kuwait City, Kuwait), and Tehran University of Medical Sciences (located in Tehran, Iran), desiring to promote cooperation in the fields of education and academic research, agree to the following:
 - 1.1 to encourage exchanges and visits in the following categories: undergraduate and graduate students, research and post-graduate fellows, and faculty members;
 - 1.2 to exchange information and materials in those fields which are of interest to both universities;
 - 1.3 to organize joint conferences and academic programs;
 - 1.4 to arrange joint research activities and publications.
- Implementation and administration of said activities will be jointly discussed and agreed on in advance. Both parties shall provide necessary support to facilitate such activities.
- 3. This Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years. It shall be extended automatically for an additional period of five years at each expiration date unless either party gives a six-month advance notice in writing to terminate the Agreement.
