Selected participants will present their work at the WHS in October in Berlin. Abstracts will be published digitally.

The Selection Process:

Step 1: Choose your topic

Issues addressed must be relevant, reflect current challenges and show originality in the overall field of Public and Global Health. Topics linked to the World Health Summit's main themes in 2016 are of particular interest:

- Health Policy in the G7/G20
- Global Health Security
- Healthy and Resilient Cities
- Vaccine Research and Development
- o Creating Global Health Innovations with Africa
- Big Data for Health Governance
- > **Step 2**: Application

Applications must consist of:

- General abstract information and contact information
- Thematic abstract of up to 500 words, written in English. It should not contain references, figures or tables (*PDF upload*).
- Brief CV (PDF upload)

> **Step 3**: Selection

The M8 Alliance Scientific Committee will identify the best applications based on international academic standards.

> **Step 4**: Design your poster

Chosen candidates will be notified by early August 2017. They will then have to design posters in DIN A0 format (841 mm x 1189 mm) / (33.1 inches x 46.8 inches) based on their abstracts. The WHS will print the posters and cover related costs.
