## QUARANTINE STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE SICK PERSON

• Quarantine is necessary for students who have been in close contact with someone who already has novel coronavirus

Quarantine means staying in your home, hotel room or provided accommodation, and not leaving for the period of time:

- You need to stay in home for 14 days from the last date of contact with the confirmed case.
- Only people who usually live in the household should be in the home.
- Do not allow visitors into the home.
- You should not attend your regular work for 14 days from the date you departed.
